In the interest of clarity, we would like to provide you with an outline of LAGBAC's criteria for recommendation for election, appointment, or retention to the bench.

First, we have evaluated your candidacy based on information gained from your written application, the Alliance's investigation, and your in-person interview with the Alliance.

Second, the LAGBAC Judicial Evaluation Committee looks for each of the following in all candidates: excellence in legal, analytical, and writing skills; demonstrated impartiality; a thorough understanding of the entire legal process; a patient and respectful temperament; a timely, complete, candid, and well-organized application; and sensitivity to issues of concern to lesbians and gay men, women, and people of color. We also consider each candidate's personal and professional integrity, character, and the extent of practice experience and community participation and service.

Based on these factors, we have found you **recommended** for election to the Circuit Court of Cook County.
